A small group of glassware, 19th century and later, including a magnum triple-ring neck decanter and matched stopper with facet cut decoration, height 33cm, and a large rummer, engraved with a monogram flanked by thistles and roses, height 17.8cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

Magnum decanter - overall (particularly noticeable on the stopper) the glass has a yellowish tinge, the end of the stopper is chipped, a large area of the underside base has been reduced and polished to disguise a chip - the remains of which are visible. Some knocks and digs to facet edges. This is probably early 20th century. Some clouding.

Engraved rummer - 19th century, in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, some surface scratches.

Faceted wine - early 20th century, in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Moulded gilt decorated goblet - late 19th/early 20th century, 3 chips to foot, otherwise ok.

2 clear decanters and stoppers- both 20th century and both bodies in good overall condition, the square example has a replacement stopper which is stuck but has a visible major chip to its base end and a small chip to its upper rim edge.
