LOT 1456

A Moore Brothers oil lamp, late 19th century, the trunk stem applied with four putti and entwined with orchid flowers and leaves beneath the similarly floral encrusted globular reservoir, the pierced foot with gilt enriched foliate scrollwork, brown printed factory mark to base, height 50.5cm (faults, converted to electricity), together with a similar lampbase, height 29.5cm (restored).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Oil Lamp - fundamentally in good overall condition with no significant damage or repair. There are typical losses to the applied flowers and foliage, primarily to the reservoir. The putti all in good order with no losses. There is a horizontal branched haircrack to the main stem near the base, running approx half the circumference. The electrical conversion is through the mounts - the porcelain has not been drilled.
Lampbase - badly broken and restored, drilled near base for electrical conversion.
