LOT 1774

Two plain stem wine glasses, mid to late 18th century, each funnel bowl raised on a plain stem and conical foot, height 15.8cm and 15.2cm, together with a small group of glass, including a pair of ruby flashed decanters and stoppers, height 32cm (faults).

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1774. Pair of 19th century cut glass decanters - both with a number of chips to base, facet edges and stoppers. Clouding to very base of decanter.

Pair of late 19th century ruby flash decanters and stoppers - one neck repaired, large section of rim missing.

Two chips to top of stopper.

Pair of footed decanters and stoppers - both with clouding to interior. One stopper broken into three pieces.

Large reproduction wine glass, signed Peter Tysoe to base - in good condition.

Larger 18th century wine - small chip and tiny nick to rim of bowl.

Smaller 18th century wine - in generally good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
