### LOT 1050

A Seiko 6215-7000 Automatic stainless steel cased diver's wristwatch, circa 1967, the signed and jewelled movement detailed 'Japan' and numbered '002416', the signed black dial with centre seconds, luminous hour markers, date aperture and detailed 'Seiko Automatic Water 300M Proof Diashock 35 Jewels Japan 6215-7000T AD', the case with rotating bezel, the signed case back detailed '6215-7000' over '7400335', case diameter 4.4cm, on a black leather strap, the buckle detailed 'Uncle Seiko', together with original scratched crystal.

### Condition Report

1050. In generally good, but used/second hand, condition. Typical surface scratches and wear to case. Typical scratches and wear to bezel. Dial in generally good order with small scratch above the date aperture and some minor deterioration to the luminous markers. No significant damage or repairs. The bezel moves freely and the watch is currently in good working order but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Entered by a collector who informed us that the watch was overhauled/lubricated relatively recently, with new seals/gaskets and new glass. The original glass is also included with the Lot.

Images 8 and 9 on our website (the movement and dial) were not taken by Tooveys, but supplied by the vendor as they were taken during cleaning/overhaul. The watch is in fully assembled order.

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
