A late 19th century French slate and marble mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the two piece enamel dial with visible Brocot escapement and black Roman hour numerals, the case with plinth base, height 26.5cm, with pendulum and winding key.

Condition Report

1087. The clock appears to be in generally good clean condition.

The case has no significant damage or repairs. The two-piece enamel dial also in good clean condition.

The movement winds smoothly and runs for 10 minutes or so, but does not maintain power. The passing strike mechanism strikes correctly with a single strike on each hour.

If probably only requires a clean/overhaul to return to full working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
