A late 19th/early 20th century French lacquered brass gorge cased carriage clock with eight day movement repeating and striking on a bell, the backplate stamped '471', the enamel dial with Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Reid & Sons Newcastle on Tyne', the gorge case with swing handle and bevelled glass panels, height 15.2cm.

1127. The clock is in cosmetically very good clean condition. All glass panels appear in good order and case is nice and clean with only very minor typical light surface scratches and wear. The clock however does not wind or run.
