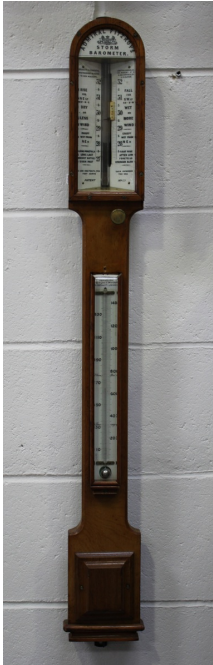

A late Victorian pale oak cased 'Admiral Fitzroys' storm barometer, the ceramic dial with vernier scales and detailed 'Negretti & Zambra... London', the stick case with glazed arch panel above a chamfered trunk with mercury thermometer and a moulded rectangular cistern cover, height 102.3cm (small section of moulding missing to thermometer case and dial repaired).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

111. The ceramic vernier scale dials are both cracked in numerous places and repaired. The thermometer box is missing the top piece of moulding. Typical scuffs and nicks to case. Otherwise fairly sound. There does not appear to be enough mercury in the tube, as it is only just visible at the bottom of the dial.
