An early 20th century lacquered brass cased carriage clock with eight day movement striking hours and half hours on a gong, the backplate stamped 'R&Co', the enamel dial with black Roman numerals and inscribed 'John Walker 127 Fenchurch St London', the corniche case with bevelled glass panels and swing handle, height including handle 16.4cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1107. The clock is cosmetically in good condition. All glass panels appear to be sound and the lacquered brass case is in good order with only typical light surface scratches and wear. The dial is also in good clean condition. The strike mechanism winds smoothly and is in working order, even though the hammer arm is a little wobbly. The movement does not wind and the clock does not run.

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
