Condition Report

1134. The case is in generally good clean condition. Split to the veneer on top, otherwise just typical light scuffs etc. Dial is good and clean.

The movement winds smoothly, but only runs for a very short period of time. The strike mechanism works as it should, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
