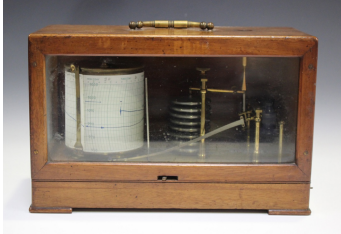

An early 20th century mahogany cased barograph with lacquered brass mechanism and clockwork recording drum, detailed 'Short & Mason Ltd London No. 80', the hinged cover with brass carry handle above glazed front and side panels, on a plinth base fitted with single drawer, length 31.5cm, together with a late 19th century French lacquered brass cased holosteric barometer, case diameter 12.3cm.

### Condition Report

1162. In generally good condition, if a little dirty and dusty, would benefit from a clean. Two glass panels in good order. Case with typical light surface scratches and scuffs. The movement winds smoothly and is currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any item. The arm is slightly misshapen, but not broken and is currently resting just below half way on the drum and moves when adjusted.
