A pair of George II silver circular salts, fitted with blue glass liners, on scroll legs and hoof feet, London 1735, diameter 6cm (marks rubbed), with two matched silver salt spoons, total weight 135.4g.

Condition Report

316. Both salts are in fair but worn condition, with no significant damage or repairs, but one has a couple of small dents to the sides. Both with typical surface scratches and wear commensurate with age. Both marks are rubbed. Later glass liners are in good condition and a decent fit. Two silver salt spoons are later and not matching.
