LOT 504

A gold and cornelian seal ring, the rectangular cornelian with intaglios to either side, the mount of serpentine design, ring size approx K1/2, a gold mounted rock crystal fob seal, circa 1800, engraved with a floral initial 'C', height 2.7cm, and a gold mounted faceted citrine hexagonal roller seal, width 2cm, total weight 13.3g.

Condition Report

504. Cornelian ring – rotation of cornelian is rather tight, the shank fitting is a little bent preventing smooth rotation. Owl crest chipped to one side where it meets the pin running through, Pegasus to the other side has small shallow chip to the edge. Serpentine shank is a bit distorted.

Rock crystal fob seal – small signs of wear to the top, the gold mount is in good condition.

Citrine roller seal – small signs of wear to the facet edges, otherwise in good condition. On one facet the text reads 'God bless you' and on the other 'Maria'. The other four sides are all plain.
