A late Victorian 15ct gold pendant cross, Chester 1894, weight 2.8g, length 3.4cm, with a gold neckchain on a cylindrical clasp, detailed '9ct', weight 1.2g, length 45.5cm, a 9ct gold ring in a beaded and interwoven design, ring size approx O, and a gold and seed pearl set bar brooch, detailed '9ct', weight 4.5g, width 5cm.

Condition Report

507. Pendant cross – good condition, no inscription, clear hallmark. Top of suspension loop a bit worn. The links are worn on the neckchain, the safety of the cross is at risk.

9ct gold ring – is rather dirty, the ring is a modern interpretation of an Edwardian design, too dirty to read hallmark.

Brooch – pearls are a bit grubby, would benefit from cleaning.

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
