A gold and diamond brooch, designed as a diamond nine stone cluster, mounted with the principal cushion cut diamond within a surround of eight smaller cushion cut diamonds, otherwise set with a row of three graduated cushion cut diamonds, detailed '9ct', weight 4.9g, width 5.4cm.

Condition Report

515. The nine stone diamond cluster has been converted from a ring. There is some wear to the platinum edging of the diamonds, this requires building up. Cluster would benefit from returning to use as a ring. Part of the under gallery has been removed in two places. The other three diamonds are old cut stones. Some variation of colour to the diamonds. The claws are secure.

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
