A George III silver caddy spoon with scallop shell bowl and bright cut engraved handle, London 1792 by George Wintle, length 7.9cm, together with a Victorian silver Fiddle and Thread pattern sauce ladle, London 1851, two other silver caddy spoons, Exeter 1825 by George Turner and Birmingham 1989, a pair of silver Fiddle pattern mustard spoons, London 1847, and a pair of silver sugar tongs, total weight 163.6g.

Condition Report

413. Bright cut caddy spoon - a little tired and worn, handle is slightly misshapen/bent, bowl has numerous dents and wear. Good clear hallmarks.

Sauce ladle - good condition. Typical light surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage or repairs. Good clear hallmarks.

Fiddle caddy spoon - good condition. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks.

Other caddy spoon - good condition with some wear and typical surface scratches. Good clear hallmarks.

Pair of salt spoons - good condition. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks.

Sugar tongs are ok, but slight misshaping to claws and curved end. Good clear hallmarks.
