An early 20th century Continental silver and enamel rectangular box, the enamelled hinged lid painted with a scene of a courting couple within foliate scroll engraved borders, the similarly decorated sides with sprung lipstick compartment to front, the hinged lid interior fitted with a mirror, length 7.2cm, weight 112.6g.

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

443. There is a small area of damage/loss to the enamel on the front right corner of the lid. Otherwise the box is in generally good condition. Typical light surface scratches and wear to other enamel panels, but no significant damage or repairs. Engraving is good and crisp. Interior in good order. Would benefit from a clean. The push button spring hinge lid and lipstick compartment are in good working order.
