## LOT 505

A Georgian cornelian pendant fob seal, crest engraved, height 2.8cm, a seal modelled as the standing figure of Napoleon, total height 3.3cm, a Victorian malachite seal and five further seals, including one incorporating a compass and a watch key, together with an iron stand, modelled as a four-tiered whatnot, height 15.8cm.

## Condition Report

505. Cornelian fob seal – The mount is a little worn. The intaglio has a few surface scuff marks.

Napoleon seal – has skull and cross bones intaglio. Good condition. Height excluding suspension loop 3cm.

Malachite seal – the malachite handle is not made from one piece of malachite, it is constructed from three separate sections. The malachite intaglio is a bit worn. Height – 2.8cm.

Compass seal/watch key – some rust staining as a result of damp intrusion within the glazing of the compass.

Mount is generally rather worn. Cornelian intaglio rather worn.

Rock crystal seal – some surface wear to facet edges and some internal flaws are visible.

Gilt metal and agate seal – has bull head crest within a garter surround. Mount is a bit worn.

Small Georgian gold seal with cross-hatched underside - Ok condition.

Gilt metal seal with moulded glass flowers - a bit worn with resulting loss of gilding, owl crest in good condition.

Seals would benefit from very careful professional cleaning in some instances.

Iron stand – one hook missing from second tier up from the bottom. Other hooks present. Slight rusting. Acorn finial of rather basic casting quality. Otherwise generally attractive.
