An 18ct gold, ruby and diamond two stone ring, claw set with a cushion cut ruby and a cushion cut diamond in a crossover design, weight 3.3g, ring size approx N1/2, with a case.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

575. The diamond has one or two pique inclusions and a bad chip to the underside of the stone between two claws, and a further chip to the girdle between two claws on the other side of the stone. The ruby is of medium colour saturation. It has two or three surface reaching inclusions, particularly one on the table facet of the stone. The claws are in good condition. Hallmark - Sheffield 1982.
