### LOT 671

A gold and pietra-dura panel link bracelet, the six oval panels decorated with differing floral designs, on a snap clasp, weight 35.1g, length 18.5cm.

Estimate: £650 - £750

### Condition Report

671. The end panel six has a natural ridge running through the back of it but this does not appear to be subsequent damage and is not visible from the front. Otherwise minor flaws to the slate backings of the mosaics but generally good condition. There is some evidence of re-enforcing glue to the edges of the backs of the settings. Some of the panels are out of consecutive order and may in the past have been out of their settings and not correctly reassembled. They are numbered 6, 2, 3, 5, 4 and 1. Some of the wire borders which do not perfectly match each other are out of alignment and are not perfectly fitted in place. Suggested age – the panels second half 19th century. The settings are probably of late 20th century manufacturer.
