A gold, platinum and diamond eight stone cluster ring, claw set with the principal cushion cut diamond within a surround of seven further cushion cut diamonds between diamond three stone shoulders, detailed '18c Plat' weight 4g, ring size approx U.

Estimate: £700 - £900

Condition Report

680. The ring is currently rather dirty and would benefit from professional cleaning. One of the surrounding diamonds has a fracture chip running down the side of the top of the diamond just encroaching the table facet edge. Scratch mark across the diamond next to this. The ring is in fairly good condition, some of the claws will eventually need re-tipping. There is some wear to each side of the top of the ring as a result of contact with other rings. Unfortunately we are unable to provide professional colour and clarity grading for this ring. Approx diameter of top of ring- 1.3cm. There is some variation of cut to the diamonds resulting in variation of size and faceting. Suggested age - 1950s/60s but the diamonds might have been in 19th century settings in the past.

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
