LOT 765

A gold backed and silver fronted, diamond and emerald brooch, designed as a floral and foliate spray, mounted with the principal circular cut diamond within a surround of eight circular cut emeralds, otherwise mounted with eight cut diamonds, the central flowerhead fitted en tremblant, weight 12.1g, width 5.5cm (one diamond lacking on one leaf).

Estimate: £350 - £450

Condition Report

765. The central diamond is an attractive white stone that looks to be fairly clear. The remaining diamonds are generally attractive clear stones, one has a fracture chip extending from the edge of the table facet down the side of the stone. Brooch would benefit from careful professional cleaning. Pin is a bit bent. Minor use of lead solder used at the back of the mount. The sides of the brooch appear rather compacted thus rendering the leaves at this point obscured from vision by the flowerhead. This would benefit from realignment. Suggested age – as the diamonds are fairly modern cuts, mid-20th century.

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
