An Edwardian silver mounted engraved and cut glass claret jug, the tapered cylindrical body with floral garlands beneath hobnail cutting, Sheffield 1909 by George Wish, height 27cm, together with a silver mounted clear glass decanter and stopper, height 24cm.

Condition Report

334. The claret jug is in good clean condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches. Good clear hallmarks.

The decanter has numerous tiny nicks/chips to facet edges on the body, but no significant damage or repairs. Minor dents to silver collar where stopper has made contact, but otherwise silver collar in good order with good clear hallmarks. Stopper in good order and its tightly.
