### LOT 751

A gold mounted oval shell cameo brooch, carved as a portrait of a lady, detailed '9ct', fitted with a safety chain, weight 7.6g, length 4.1cm, six further brooches, a gilt metal and paste scatter pin, designed as a butterfly, with a case, a stickpin, mounted with a cultured pearl, cased, a length of chain, spaced with turquoises, and part of an oval locket.

Estimate: £70 - £100

### Condition Report

751. Gold mounted shell cameo - pin bent, otherwise in generally good condition.

Circular brooch - central dome possibly a later replacement as loose in fitting, also dented in places.

Other cameo - a section of the left hand side is missing, a number of solder repairs to reverse of mount.

Scatter butterfly pin - one purple paste lacking on wing.

Pink oval cameo - a number of cracks to surface.

Deer brooch - one antler bent backwards, some damage to enamel.

Part of oval locket - lacking back.

Turquoise chain - length 10cm, the rest lacking.

Other items in generally good condition.
