A Victorian silver three-piece tea set, comprising teapot, milk jug and two-handled sugar bowl, each piece of circular bombé form with engraved decoration, Sheffield 1865 by Hawkesworth, Eyre & Co, total weight 1454.5g, height of teapot 19cm.

Condition Report

375. Teapot - generally good condition with typical light surface wear and scratches. Dent to the body on the crest panel and a couple of small dents to opposing vacant panel. Engraving still fairly crisp with good detail. All four feet bases are worn through to small holes. Hinge is good. Handle slightly wobbly. Good clear hallmarks.

Sugar bowl - generally good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear. One handle slightly pushed in at lower join. Engraving still fairly crisp with good detail. Two of the feet are worn through to holes. It sits slightly wobbly. Good clear hallmarks. Interior a little dirty.

Jug - generally good condition with typical light wear and surface scratches. Numerous small dents to low belly of body. Engraving slightly more worn than other two pieces. Two feet worn through to holes. Good clear hallmarks.
