An 18ct gold and diamond cluster ring, claw set with the principal cushion cut diamond within a surround of ten smaller cushion cut diamonds between split shoulders, weight 4.5g, ring size approx R1/2, with a case.

Condition Report

721. One or two claws are beginning to show signs of wear, but the stones are secure at present. There is some wear to the shank, but no evidence of re-sizing. The central diamond is bright, white and sparkly. It appears to be a fairly clear stone under magnification. The surrounding diamonds have a faint yellow tint to them and have one or two internal inclusions. The ring would benefit from a professional clean.
