A pair of 19th century giltwood and gesso framed convex wall mirrors, each with eagle surmount and foliate sprays, the circular mirrors within ball shot borders, height 92cm, width 53cm (some faults).

Estimate: £200 - £400

Condition Report

2012. The two mirrors appear to have original gilding and gesso to the circular frames and ball shots, albeit with some flaking and chips. The crest and foliate apron appear to be slightly later carved and definitely later gesso covered and gilded, as there is a lack of definition to the carving and the gilding is a bit more yellowy than the rest of the mirrors.
