Condition Report

1030. Jar and cover 1) generally good condition, typical light surface scratches and minor wear to enamels and gilt. Jar with no chips, cracks or repairs. Small black glaze blemish to base. The cover has been broken in two and professionally repaired with some minor restoration.

Jar and cover 2) jar in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels and gilt. The cover has been broken into three pieces and has been professionally repaired with some minor overpainting/restoration.
