A Chinese famille rose enamelled pale blue ground porcelain bottle vase, late 19th century, decorated with a magpie and butterfly flying amidst peony and chrysanthemum, beneath a ruyi head band, unmarked, height 39.8cm (some wear to enamels and gilt).

Condition Report

1226. The vase is in generally good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs, however it is a little worn. There is typical scratches and wear to surface enamels, with more pronounced wear to certain areas around the body. Also a few minor areas of flaking to enamels. Gilt rim also rubbed. Please note - the coloured band at the top of neck which appears dirty in the the online images has cleaned up and is now a clean white glazed band.
