A Chinese famille rose enamelled sang-de-boeuf glazed jar and cover, late Qing dynasty, the ovoid body enamelled with two pheasants perched on rocks amidst peony and blossoming prunus branches, unmarked, height 42.5cm (minor faults).

## Condition Report

1016. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs.

The jar has some crazing to the glaze and typical wear to enamels, as well as some surface scratches to glaze. Some typical minor chips to footrim. There is a body crack visible to interior.

The cover has similar wear to enamel and scratches to the glaze. Uneven surface and numerous chips to the rim of cover and chips to the sang-de-boeuf glaze. One chip with small hairline crack running off it.
