A Chinese flambé glazed snuff bottle, probably early 20th century, of pebble form, covered in a pale blue to purple streaky glaze, fitted with white metal foliate shoulder mount and stopper, length 7.7cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1003. Generally good condition with some typical light surface scratches and wear. Some light crazing visible under magnification. Just below the white metal mount there appears to be a very small section of glaze (approximately 4mm x 4mm) which looks like it has had a small bit of superglue over it, possibly where it was starting to flake/become unstable. White metal mounts in good order, but with typical light wear. Stopper has a few small dents to top and sides, but otherwise ok.
