A Chinese powder blue glazed porcelain rouleau vase, Qing dynasty, covered in a speckled blue glaze, height 42.5cm (firing crack to base).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

1279. The vase is in generally good condition. The underside of the base has a firing crack around the footrim, which appears to have been filled and there is a star crack inside this firing crack running to the edges of the firing crack, but no further. Darker glaze blemish to one side of vase and a few other minor glaze blemishes. Typical light surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage, cracks or repairs.
