A Chinese 'clobbered' blue and white export porcelain gublet, 18th century, painted in underglaze blue with a coastal landscape, later embellished in iron red and gilt with flowers, unmarked, height 23.5cm (minor hairlines to rim).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1023. The body of the gublet is in generally good condition with only typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels and gilt. Faint dark speckling to glaze where misfired. Possibly slightly reduced rim and three small hairlines to rim, all between 1.5cm and 2.5cm in length.
