A small group of Chinese blue and white porcelain, Qianlong period and later, including a ginger jar, late 19th century, painted with prunus, height 19.5cm, a similarly decorated baluster vase, height 30cm, four export porcelain plates, diameters 23cm, and four ginger jars (some faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1124. Ovoid jar - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Baluster vase - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Larger globular jar and cover - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

2 smaller jars (no covers) - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. One slightly stained.

Circular export plate - hairline crack (9cm long) running from footrim to footrim across base. Otherwise only very minor chips and typical wear and surface scratches.

Darker blue octagonal export plate - 2 faint hairlines to rim, one 2cm long, the other 4cm. Otherwise in good order with minor rim fritting, typical wear and surface scratches.

Pair of octagonal plates - 1) with 3.5cm hairline to rim, minor rim chips/fritting to glaze and typical wear. 2) 2 x hairline cracks to rim (5cm x 3.5cm long). Otherwise minor fritting/rim chips to glaze and typical wear.
