Two Chinese pale celadon jade pendants, late 19th/20th century, the first carved in the form of a fish and lotus pod, length 5cm, the second of square form, carved in relief with a chilong to one side and 'C' scrolls to the other, width 4.6cm, together with a Chinese pebble jade carving, early 20th century, one side carved in low relief with two rams chewing lingzhi branches, length 8.5cm.

1111. Square pendant has very minor nicks to edges, but otherwise good condition.

Gourd and fish pendant - in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical minor scuffs and scratches.
