A Chinese moulded 'twin bat' porcelain bowl, mark of Daoguang and possibly of the period, moulded in relief with a pair of confronting bats with outstretched wings, the heads forming the handles, painted in iron red and gilt, reserved against a blue enamelled incised wave ground, the interior turquoise glazed, iron red painted seal mark to base, height 9cm, length 14.8cm.

Condition Report

1200. Good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze, enamels and gilt. Very light crazing to turquoise enamel interior.
