A Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain vase, mid to late 19th century, the compressed circular body and flared neck painted with opposing figural scenes reserved against a turquoise ground filled with birds, fruit and flowers, on a flared circular foot, height 34cm (crack to foot).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

1220. There is a hairline crack to the footrim which runs up into the body of the vase (approximately 13cm long). There is also a firing crack to the foot, but only visible from underside. There is a horizontal 4cm long firing crack just below the rim with a 1cm hairline crack running vertically up from it. Otherwise generally good condition with vibrant enamels and only typical minor surface scratches and wear to enamels and gilt.
