1186. The large bowl is in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Good vibrant enamels and gilt. Typical light wear to gilt on rim and typical light crazing to glaze.

Small bowl - good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light crazing, minor wear to gilt and enamels, slightly more pronounced on rim.
