William Shayer Junior - White Rock, Hastings, mid-19th century oil on panel, indistinctly signed, diameter 29cm, within a gilt composition frame with foliate strapwork mouldings.

Condition Report

10. Cleaned and restored. Restoration includes a split to the panel which has been repaired with diamond-shaped cradles and associated overpainting. U.V. examination highlights some other areas of overpainting throughout, including a scratch or split to the white rock and touches to details lost during previous cleans. Some craquelure throughout. The paint has rubbed around the edge of the mount with loss. Some minor surface dirt despite being kept behind glass.

Frame in generally good condition but with some minor cracks to the composition and general rubbing to extremities.
