A 19th century steel parrying dagger with double-edged diamond-section blade, blade length 21.5cm, the downward curved quillions with central ring guard, together with a brass-handled kukri knife.

2453. The parrying dagger has an overall surface rust and pitting, the wire bound grip is a bit worn, but otherwise ok.

The kukri has some overall rust and pitting to blade. Blade length 35cm, total length 46cm.
