Condition Report

Buff paper gives the appearance of age-toning, and while the paper has probably toned it isn't as severe as it appears. Very light crease to the top right corner. Paper does have a very minor ripple to it. Probably slightly faded but colours are generally okay. No signs of foxing. Mount and backing do not appear to be archival. The frame has a small chip to the top section and some other minor scuffs and scratches. This work has not been examined out of the frame.
