A set of eight impressive late 19th/early 20th century carved oak dining chairs with overall profusely carved foliate scrolls and rosettes, comprising two carvers, height 143cm, width 75cm, and six standards, height 129cm, width 48cm.

### Condition Report

2002. Height to seat - 47cm.

The overall appearance and condition is good, having a polished surface and clean upholstery. One of the carvers has a repaired crest to the back and the other has a thin crack to the lower panel on the back. Due to the very tall backs of the standard chairs, most of them do have some movement to the joints. Most have had repaired lower leg/stretcher joints and most do have some slight movement to the joints. No signs of woodworm and some minor loss to the finials.
