A 1796 pattern light cavalry officer's sword, the curved single-edged blade with clipped-back tip and etched with trophy of arms and foliate motifs, blade length 82cm, the steel stirrup hilt with wire-bound leather grip, with black-painted steel scabbard.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

2401. The scabbard is dented and also split to one edge. The blade is quite loosely attached to the hilt, but the blade and hilt seem to be reasonably straight. The blade has one slight nick in its edge. The metalwork has overall light surface pitting. The wire binding on the handle is a bit loose, but not necessarily replaced.
