An early 19th century silver child's rattle with whistle terminal, decorated with flowers and scrolls, hung with eight bells and fitted with a coral teether, maker's mark 'IP', length 15.2cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

422. Generally good condition with no significant damage. Would benefit from a clean. Typical light surface wear commensurate with age.

Coral in generally good order with a small natural blemish near to where it meets silver and under magnification you can see a faint hairline to one side.

There is a small lead repair to either side of the aperture on the whistle and a small tear to the front edge of this aperture. Bells all appear to be original and in generally good order with only typical wear and few small dents.
