A George III Hepplewhite period mahogany oval Pembroke table with tulipwood crossbanded borders and boxwood stringing, the top with an inlaid shell patera, height 75cm, extended width 78cm, depth 100cm.

Condition Report

2005. The table has some overall minor surface scuffs, marks and scratches. There are a few very minor nicks off the veneered crossbanding. The top has two visible, but minor, creases in the veneer where the carcass wood has moved slightly underneath. Otherwise in fair condition.
