A pair of diamond pendant cluster earrings, each claw set with the principal cushion cut diamond within a surround of twelve cushion cut diamonds with diamond set two stone surmounts, with post and butterfly fittings, unmarked, weight 4.3g, each principal diamond weight approx 0.60ct, clarity approx VS, colour approx G/H, length 2.1cm, diameter of each cluster 0.9cm, with a case.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

525. The diamonds are attractive bright white stones. Both principal diamonds with a couple of small chips to the girdle. The earrings are in good condition but would benefit from careful professional cleaning. Suggested age, 1960s perhaps. They are unmarked but are probably platinum. Each surmount diamond weight approx. 0.35ct, clarity approx VS, colour approx G/H. Total diamond weight approx. 2.20ct.

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
