A Victorian gold and turquoise pendant with a cross motif, glazed with a locket compartment to the back, unmarked, weight 1.7g, length 2.3cm, a silver mounted compass fob, Birmingham 1902, weight 4.8g, length 2.7cm, two moulded coloured glass dog charms, four further pendants and charms and a pair of turquoise matrix drop earrings.

Condition Report

623. Turquoise heart pendant | slight variation of colour to the turquoise, one or two dents to the border of the locket at the back. Compass fob | glass is cracked on one side in several places, otherwise numerous surface scratches. Compass needle still moving. Purple dog charm | one paste lacking from one eye, one or two chips around the base, base metal collar is rather corroded.

Yellow dog charm | the pastes are lacking from both eyes, moulding flaw which looks like a crack down the back of the dog, one or two small chips around the base and to the front paw. Base metal collar is a little corroded.

Brass bird charm | is lacking most of its colour finish.

Turquoise earrings | in good condition.

Banded agate locket | only one side survives, mount and back agate missing.

Ladybird pendant | moulded but fair condition.

Earring drop | lacking top fitting and is base metal.

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
