LOT 711

A gold, ruby and diamond ring in a triple cluster design, mounted with three cushion cut rubies surrounded by variously cut diamonds between split shoulders, weight 2.9g, ring size approx O.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

711. The three rubies are of medium colour saturation. The rubies have internal inclusions which are surface reaching, particularly to one of the side rubies. The rubies have some wear to the table facet edges. The diamonds have some variation of cut and are slightly drawing colour. The diamonds have one or two internal inclusions. The ring is slightly worn to the sides as a result of contact with other rings. One of the claws on one of the side rubies requires adjustment to make it more secure, the ruby having slightly dropped in its setting. There are no hallmarks to the band. Colour of gold and density of the ring would suggest high carat gold, possibly 18ct. The ring has been sized in the past. From the style of design, suggested age 1960s. Rubies - central diameter approx 2.5mm, sides diameter approx 2mm.

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
