## LOT 700

An 18ct gold and ruby ring, mounted with three cushion cut rubies alternating with two pairs of cushion cut diamonds, Birmingham 1915, weight 2.8cm, ring size approx M.

## Condition Report

700. The rubies appear to be fairly clear stones and are well matched for colour. One of the side rubies has a chip to the edge of the table facet. Otherwise the rubies have some minor wear to the facet edges, particularly the table facets.

The diamonds have slight variation of colour and are fairly included stones. One diamond has a small chip by one claw. Some claws are showing signs of wear and require re-tipping. The shank is inscribed 'JH to MM 6/8/17'. The shank is ever so slightly misshapen. Otherwise the ring is in generally good condition.

Central ruby dimensions - length approx 4.5mm, width approx 4.5mm.

Side rubies dimensions - approx 3mm x 2mm.

Diamonds - diameter approx 2mm.
