LOT 692

A gold, platinum, sapphire and diamond oval cluster ring, claw set with the oval cut sapphire within a surround of ten circular cut diamonds, detailed '18ct Plat', weight 5g, ring size approx N, with a case.

Estimate: £400 - £500

Condition Report

692. The sapphire is of medium to dark colour saturation and has a definite green/blue tint in certain lighting. There is some internal colour zoning on one side, faintly noticeable without magnification, in the same area a faint inclusion again noticeable without magnification. Otherwise the sapphire is a fairly clear stone. There are a few tiny nicks to facet edges of the stone.

The surrounding diamonds are quite bright, white and sparkly, generally with one or two internal inclusions. The claws are in generally good condition. There is a small crack to the shank where it joins the cluster, perhaps a result of sizing the ring. The shank otherwise has typical light surface scratching and some minor thinning to the back of the shank. The ring is overall in generally good condition.

Sapphire dimensions - length approx 9.5mm, width approx 7mm.

Diamonds - diameter approx 2mm.

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
