An Edwardian gold and diamond nine stone cluster ring, mounted with cushion cut diamonds, the principal diamond mounted to the centre between ridged shoulders, detailed '18ct', weight 3.6g, ring size approx N1/2, with a case.

Condition Report

655. The ring is quite dirty and would benefit from a professional clean. The diamonds appear to be fairly clear stones, with one or two small chips to table facet edges. The ring has possibly been resized in the past. The claws are beginning to show signs of wear and may need re-tipping in the near future. Otherwise the ring is generally in good condition.
